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Training Course on Research Methodology in Social Sciences for Research Scholars (February 10 to 19, 2020)

Introduction

Social science research is characterised by a diversity of theoretical perspectives, methodological strategies, data collection practices and analysis techniques. This has made it always necessary to provide training and orientation for researchers and teachers to equip them with advanced methodological skills. It has been observed that many researchers could not produce research works of high quality because they are either not in touch with the latest research tools and techniques or do not have proper orientation to use the traditional research methods efficiently. The problem has further been aggravated by lack of opportunities for the Ph.D. scholars to refine their methodological skills and to get insight in fresh areas of research in their respective fields. On the other hand the rapid advancement of knowledge in all disciplines of social sciences has made research an activity of solving problems, which adds new dimensions and generalisations on the basis of gathered empirical evidences. Recognising this need, M.P. Institute of Social Science Research, Ujjain (MPISSR) is organising a ten days *Training Course on Research Methodology in Social Science* Research, New Delhi.

The objectives of this course are to help participants to acquire intensive knowledge and understanding on the various aspects of research methodology in social sciences. The training programme strives to highlight some emerging philosophical and methodological issues emerging in social science research. The programme of the course will inculcate discussions on formation and selection of a research problem; designing of research; sampling techniques; tools for data collection; analysis of data; interpretation and discussion of results and report writing. The aim of the training course is to enable the participants to formulate relevant research objectives, select and make use of suitable research methods; to use appropriate research tools and to analyse their data properly to conduct their research.
